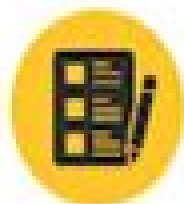

Scheduling, budgeting and writing storyboards/outlines



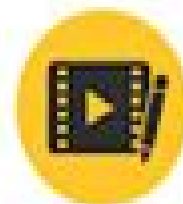

Capturing and storing as much footage as possible



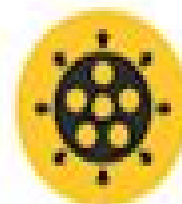
