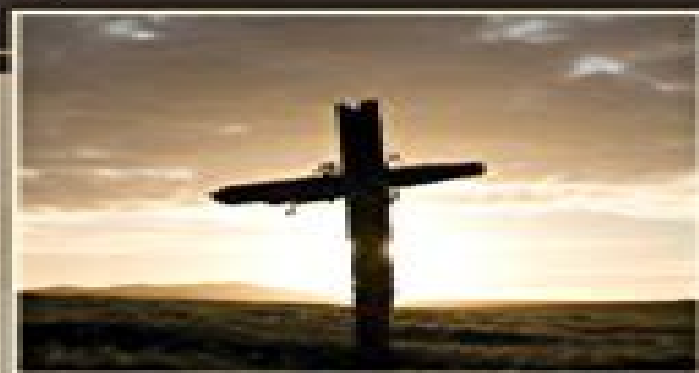

political Powers God's raising of Jesus completes the story and vindicates Jesus's life and teaching. The book also examines the understandings of salvation in Romans and Revelation that reinforce the message that salvation is a gift of God and that Jesus's work has to do with his faithful life, his resistance to the Powers, and God's vindication of him through resurrection. The book concludes that the Bible's salvation story provides a different way instead of atonement to understand salvation. In turn, this biblical understanding gives us today theological resources for a mercy-oriented approach to responding to wrongdoing, one that follows God's own model.
