


PEDIATRIC FIRST AID

2nd Edition



Accidents can happen, anywhere, anytime. Knowing how to provide proper care can save a child's life. First aid can range from calling emergency medical personnel (911) to performing more advanced procedures such as administering CPR. Guidelines in this chart are specific to "non-health care professionals".

STEP 1: SURVEY THE SCENE

- If there is any kind of danger, call Emergency Medical Services (EMS) (911) first.
- Ensure the scene is safe for you and others.
- Look for things that may threaten your safety, such as fire, electrical wires, or dangerous fluids.
- If you feel your safety is threatened, stay back and allow professionals to handle any dangerous situations.

STEP 2: CHECK FOR RESPONSIVENESS

- Gently tap child and shout "Are you okay?"
- For infants, tap on their hands and feet and call their name.
- If the casualty responds, begin a Secondary Survey (see pg. 2).
- If the casualty is conscious (but appears to be choking), use "First Aid for Choking Child with Complete Airway Obstruction".
- If the casualty does not respond, send someone to call EMS (911).
- If you are alone and dealing with the child or infant, give care for 2 minutes first, then call EMS (911).
- Return and begin the Primary Survey (see below).

STEP 3: PRIMARY SURVEY

- The Primary Survey will help you to determine if any conditions threaten the casualty's life.
- Roll the casualty onto his or her back if they are not breathing or only gasping, or if the casualty's position keeps you from checking their breathing.
 - Kneel beside the casualty on the side they are not facing.
 - Roll the casualty toward you, "face up/down", as a single unit - do not twist.
 - Support back of the casualty's head and neck.
- Once you have determined that the casualty is not breathing or only gasping and have rolled them onto their back, proceed to step 3a.
- Remember **CAB**: circulation, airway, breathing.
- If the casualty is breathing normally, proceed to step 4a. Check for Control Severe Bleeding.

- If the child starts breathing or begins to vomit, place them into recovery position (see pg. 2).
- If the child is showing signs of an injury or illness, provide on-going casualty care until EMS (911) arrives.

STEP 3: PRIMARY SURVEY (CONT)

3a. CIRCULATION: Begin Compressions

CPR for Children (1-8 Years)

Find Hand Position (see Fig. 4b): Place the heel of your hand on the child's sternum, in the center (middle) between chest muscles (straight across from their armpits), then place the heel of the second hand on top of the first so that the hands are overlapping, interlocked and parallel. You may use one or two hands to do compressions.

Give 30 Compressions (see Fig. 5b):

- Position shoulders over hands.
- Compress sternum at least 2 inches (2 cm) down and up smoothly at a rate of at least 100 times per minute.
- Keep hands in contact with the chest at all times.
- Push hard, push fast. Allow for complete recoil of chest between compressions.
- If the breaths, check hand position and keep going, do not stop.



CPR for Infants (Under 1 Year)



Find Correct Finger Position (see Fig. 4c): Place two fingers on breastbone (middle of chest) just below the infant's nipples.


Give 30 Compressions:

- Compress sternum at least 1 1/2 inches (4 cm) down and up smoothly at a rate of at least 100 times per minute.
- Keep fingers in contact with the chest at all times.
- Push hard, push fast. Allow for complete recoil of chest between compressions.

3b. AIRWAY: Open the Airway

• Do "Head-tilt/chin-lift" if neck injury is not suspected (see Fig. 5c).

If head/neck injury is suspected and the person is not breathing, "non-professional" rescuers are recommended to still open airway using the "Head-tilt/chin-lift". It is most important to get air into the person. Opening the airway using other methods is difficult to do and is therefore not recommended.



3c. BREATHING: Give 2 Full Breaths

- Pinch nostrils and give 2 breaths of air, each lasting 1 second (see Fig. 6).
- Watch to see that chest rises as breaths go in.



• If breath does not go in, adjust airway by tilting the head further back (reposition) and give another breath.



- For infants use a mouth-to-mouth-and-nose technique (see Fig. 7).
- To do this, use your mouth to make a seal over the infant's mouth and nose.
- If you have difficulty making an effective seal, try either mouth-to-mouth ventilation (pinch the nose closed) or mouth-to-nose ventilation (close the mouth).

BREATHS STILL DO NOT GO IN

- Do first aid for unconscious choking child, or first aid for infant with complete airway obstruction.

BREATHS GO IN

- Deliver another 30 compressions, followed by 2 breaths. Continue cycle until:
- The area becomes dangerous.
- You are too physically exhausted to continue.
- EMS (911) arrives.
- The person starts breathing or begins to vomit.
- Another trained rescuer takes over.
- Someone arrives with an AED (Automated External Defibrillator).

CASUALTY BEGINS BREATHING: Proceed to Step 4
