- Questions often revolve around definitions of masculinity and femininity
- → Usually relies on a "bottom up" perspective
- Gender is "a socially constructed series of behaviors that code one as male or female, but that vary across time and space in such a way as to reveal their constructed nature" (Downs, Writing Gender History, 3)
