Fox, 2014-06-01 An intimate portrait of the renowned international humanitarian organization Winner of the PROSE Award for Excellence Sociology and Social Work of the Association of American Publishers This study of M decins Sans Fronti res Doctors Without Borders MSF casts new light on the organization s founding principles distinctive culture and inner struggles to realize more fully its without borders transnational vision Pioneering medical sociologist Ren e C Fox spent nearly twenty years conducting extensive ethnographic research within MSF a private international medical humanitarian organization that was created in 1971 and awarded the Nobel Prize for Peace in 1999 With unprecedented access Fox attended MSF meetings and observed doctors and other workers in the field She interviewed MSF members and participants and analyzed the content of such documents as communications between MSF staff members within the offices of its various headquarters communications between headquarters and the field and transcripts of internal group discussions and meetings Fox weaves these threads of information into a rich tapestry of the MSF experience that reveals the dual perspectives of an insider and an observer The book begins with moving detailed accounts from the blogs of women and men working for MSF in the field From there Fox chronicles the organization s early history and development paying special attention to its struggles during the first decades of its existence to clarify and implement its principles The core of the book is centered on her observations in the field of MSF s efforts to combat a rampant epidemic of HIV AIDS in postapartheid South Africa and the organization's response to two challenges in postsocialist Russia an enormous surge in homelessness on the streets of Moscow and a massive epidemic of tuberculosis in the penal colonies of Siberia Fox s accounts of these crises exemplify MSF s struggles to provide for thousands of people in need when both the populations and the aid workers are in danger Enriched by vivid photographs of MSF operations and by ironic self critical cartoons drawn by a member of the Communications Department of MSF France Doctors Without Borders highlights the bold mission of the renowned international humanitarian organization even as it demonstrates the intrinsic dilemmas of humanitarian action

and repercussions and the meaning and meaningfulness of teaching exploring questing and writing Latently associated with these themes are the author's social values and social conscience Composing these essays from a participant observer outlook heightens and enriches the author's observations over the course of her daily life enabling her to engage in mind travel to places and people she has intimately known in the past and to places she has yearningly hoped to visit but never has

Scholz, 2015-10-08 Contemporary cosmopolitan moral theorists argue that in our increasingly interconnected world all individuals need to recognize that moral duties span state borders involving responsibilities such as respecting human rights Such arguments usually focus on the duties of individuals or on reforms for international political and economic institutions The Cosmopolitan Potential of Exclusive Associations draws attention to how non state not for profit transnational associations can advance respect for equality in a plurality of less obvious ways By synthesizing moral theories of cosmopolitanism with international relations scholarship it is possible to establish criteria for assessing whether and to what extent transnational associations like M decins sans Fronti res Doctors without Borders or the International Olympic Committee cultivate respect for fellow humans and build transnational communities As these examples show not all non state associations have the mission of advocating for human rights Membership is also not necessarily inclusive of all humanity Membership criteria exclude based on criteria such as professional expertise athletic prowess or certain religious beliefs As a result assessing their impact requires looking for partial expressions of cosmopolitanism that arise piecemeal and without self conscious intention Rather than defending one version of cosmopolitan theory as more applicable to evaluating the impact of associations adapting and combining four common approaches to cosmopolitanism 1 institutional cosmopolitanism 2 natural duties cosmopolitanism 3 cultural cosmopolitanism and 4 deliberative democratic cosmopolitanism makes it possible to evaluate institutional developmental shared identity or public sphere effects of associations Applying the criteria to associations that do not self consciously advance cosmopolitanism shows the potential for partial forms of cosmopolitanism M decins sans Fronti res the first case explored provides emergency medical care across the globe without establishing a transnational community with those it aids The International Olympic Committee the second case brings the world together around global games in which national teams compete against each other Dissidents in the Anglican Communion the third case unite across borders but do so in favor of an interpretation of the Bible that excludes gay men from ordained ministry Despite non cosmopolitan elements each case has lessons about how respect for transnational equality can emerge in subtle ways without self conscious belief in cosmopolitan moral philosophy Forced Displacement and NGOs in Asia and the Pacific Gül İnanç, Themba Lewis, 2022-01-25 This volume presents a comprehensive survey of the dynamics of conflict and climate induced forced displacement and organisational response across Asia and the Pacific The Asia Pacific region hosts some of the largest numbers of displaced people on the planet with some of the fewest protections available and sparse frameworks for
