In the text, the term stakeholder is used to refer to stakeholders and constituents collectively. If the project is large, significant, or critical, it will be necessary to mount a formal program that establishes and maintains constant stakeholder linkages. Often called a *Project Public-Relations Program* (PPRP), it is designed to deal with the public and the media and requires expert staff to undertake this work.
