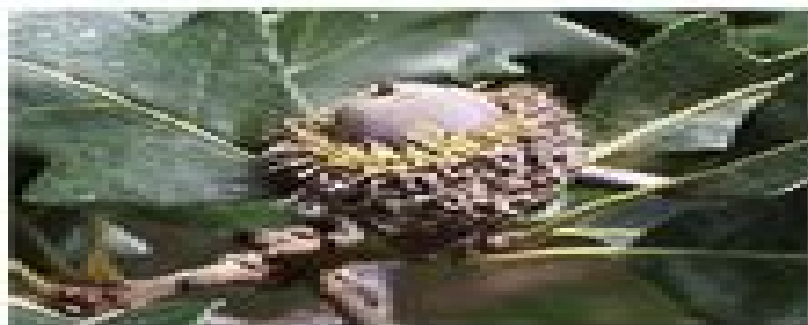

spread to eastern North America As the list of susceptible oak and understory hosts expands this guide will help fill the need to identify and determine the natural occurrence of specific oak species in eastern North America and document any potential loss of species from states or counties This field guide provides an illustrated reference for identification of eastern oaks and can be used in several ways Oak identification can be accomplished by utilizing the leaf keys cross referencing scientific or local common names in the index verifying similarities between leaf specimens and the illustrated oak leaf reference charts and comparing descriptions provided for each species Distribution maps may also aid in the separation of similar appearing species
